- Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, **thou shalt be saved**.
- Rom 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord **shall be saved**.
- Rom 11:14 If by any means I may provoke to emulation *them which are* my flesh, and **might save** some of them.
- Rom 11:26 And so all Israel **shall be saved**: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:
- 1Co 1:18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which **are saved** it is the power of God.
- 1Co 1:21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching **to save** them that believe.
- 1Co 3:15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself **shall be saved**; yet so as by fire.
- 1Co 5:5 To deliver such a one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit **may be saved** in the day of the Lord Jesus.

- 1Co 9:22 To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that **I might** by all means **save** some.
- 1Co 10:33 Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the *profit* of many, that **they may be saved**.
- 1Co 15:2 By which also **ye are saved**, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
- 2Co 2:15 For we are unto God a sweet savor of Christ, in **them that are saved**, and in them that perish:
- Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, by (grace ye are **saved**;))
- Eph 2:8 For by grace are **ye saved** through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God:
- 1Th 2:16 Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that **they might be saved**, to fill up their sins always: for the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost.
- 2Th 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they **might be saved**.
- 1Ti 1:15 This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world **to save** sinners; of whom I am chief.
- 1Ti 2:4 Who will have all men **to be saved**, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.
- 1Ti 2:15 Notwithstanding **she shall be saved** in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.
- 1Ti 4:16 Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both **save** thyself, and them that hear thee.
- 2Ti 1:9 **Who hath saved** us, and called *us* with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,
- 2Ti 4:18 And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and **will preserve** *me* unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom *be* glory forever an ever. Amen.
- Tit 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy **he saved** us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- Heb 5:7 Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able **to save** him from death, and was heard in that he feared;
- Heb 7:25 Wherefore he is able also **to save** them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.



- Jas 1:21** Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able **to save** your souls.
- Jas 2:14** What *doth it* profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have not works? can faith **save** him?
- Jas 4:12** There is one lawgiver, who is able **to save** and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?
- Jas 5:15** And the prayer of faith **shall save** the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.
- Jas 5:20** Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way **shall save** a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.
- 1Pe 3:21** The like figure whereunto *even* baptism **doth** also now **save** us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
- 1Pe 4:18** And if the righteous scarcely **be saved**, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?
- Jud 1:5** I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, **having saved** the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.
- Jud 1:23** And others **save** with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.
